DESIGNING WITH TINY MOSAICS



Micromosaics

Micromosaics are a type of mosaic created from tiny fragments of glass, called tesserae. In this program, participants will learn how to use tweezers to apply hundreds of tiny tesserae to create incredibly detailed scenes. These mosaics could be large panels or plaques inset on tabletops or mounted on the wall, but more commonly they were made into jewelry. Micromosaic pieces intended for jewelry often oval or circular plaques set into pendants, necklaces, earrings, brooches, and rings.



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Workshop Overview

In this two-day program, you will create and design your own micromosaic jewelry, and you will learn the different tools used to create micromosaic glass jewelry, how to cut glass into small tiles, and adhesive to create your pendant.



Workshop Objective

Learn how to make a beautiful piece of jewelry during this hands-on micromosaic program. Included in the class fee are the materials and tools that you will need to create your miniature work of wearable art.
